Committee of the Regions - Written Stakeholder Consultation

Mainstreaming climate, energy and environmental priorities across the Multiannual Financial Framework

The City of Tampere is a participant in the EU Mission on Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities and has experience in long-term, mission-based climate action as well as in using EU funding as part of urban development. Strengthening cities' role and implementation capacity is essential for achieving EU climate, energy and environmental goals, and this should be reflected in the future Multiannual Financial Framework.

Views of the City of Tampere

Mission-based and long-term climate action

The future MFF should support mission-based and long-term implementation of climate policy. Systemic green transition requires coherent and continuous action and cannot rely only on individual, short-term projects.

Mission cities as long-term implementation partners

Cities participating in the EU Mission on Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities should be recognised as long-term implementation partners of EU climate policy. This requires funding instruments that provide flexibility, continuity and a sufficient time horizon beyond individual funding and programme periods.

Permanent city-level capacity for implementation

Effective implementation of EU climate and environmental objectives requires permanent city-level capacity to integrate these objectives consistently into urban planning, investments and cross-sectoral decision-making as part of normal governance systems, rather than relying solely on temporary or project-based arrangements.
