Description The back in two pieces of unfigured poplar; the sides of matching wood; the scroll, also plain, the work of G.B. Genova of Turin c.1750; the table in two pieces of spruce with narrow grain at the centre, broadening towards the flanks; the varnish, somewhat retouched, of a light brown colour.

This cello is a good and characteristic example of the maker's work. Retaining its original large dimensions, it measures 77.9cm in length of body, with widths of 36.1cm and 45.3cm.
