

Letter of Intent

between the department of construction of the
Berufsschulzentrum am Westerberg in Osnabrück
and the department of construction of the
Tampere Vocational College Tredu

We, the above-mentioned partners, hereby agree to collaborate within the framework of the Key Action I, Learning Mobility of Individuals programme, a sub-programme of the Erasmus+ Programme. We agree to do our utmost to support the placements of trainees in host institutions that guarantee the quality of the mobilities developed, in accordance with the precepts of the Erasmus + program.

The proposed graduate mobility project: "2023-1-DE02-KA121-VET-000122200"

will be facilitated by our cooperation in:

- arranging an exchange programme with the agreed contents for professionals, if possible, in cooperation with sectoral organisations in the region and / or arranging an exchange programme including a work placement with the agreed contents for students, if possible, in cooperation with sectoral organisations in the region.
- helping with arranging accommodation for the students and / or professionals.
- guiding the incoming students and / or professionals and keeping contact with the sending coordinator.

During the exchanges

- the coordinators commit to making the contracts required for the exchanges and to provide the documents needed for reporting
- the coordinators commit to evaluation and provision of the outcomes using the methods defined in the project proposal document
- the coordinators contribute to ensuring the quality of mobility
- the Finnish students are generally supposed to work half of the time in a roofing company and half of the time in a tiling company.
- the Finnish students are supposed to take part in lessons at the vocational school to get acquainted with the German school system.

For the Finnish students the exchange is supposed to last 6 weeks.

- the German students are generally supposed to take part in projects worked on in the construction hall.
- the German students have to take part in a one-day safety training course before joining the project work.
- the German students need to wear safety clothing provided by the school.

For the German students the exchange is supposed to last 3 weeks.

We agree to do our utmost to maintain the European Quality Charter for Mobility. The number of staff / learner exchanges will be agreed upon according to the needs and opportunities of each partner.

Sending Organisation

The sending organisation undertakes to ensure that the participants have taken out health, accident, public liability and personal liability insurance.

The sending organisation undertakes to ensure that students carry an A1 certificate stating that they are currently undergoing training in Germany.

The partners will not contribute to each other financially.

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
